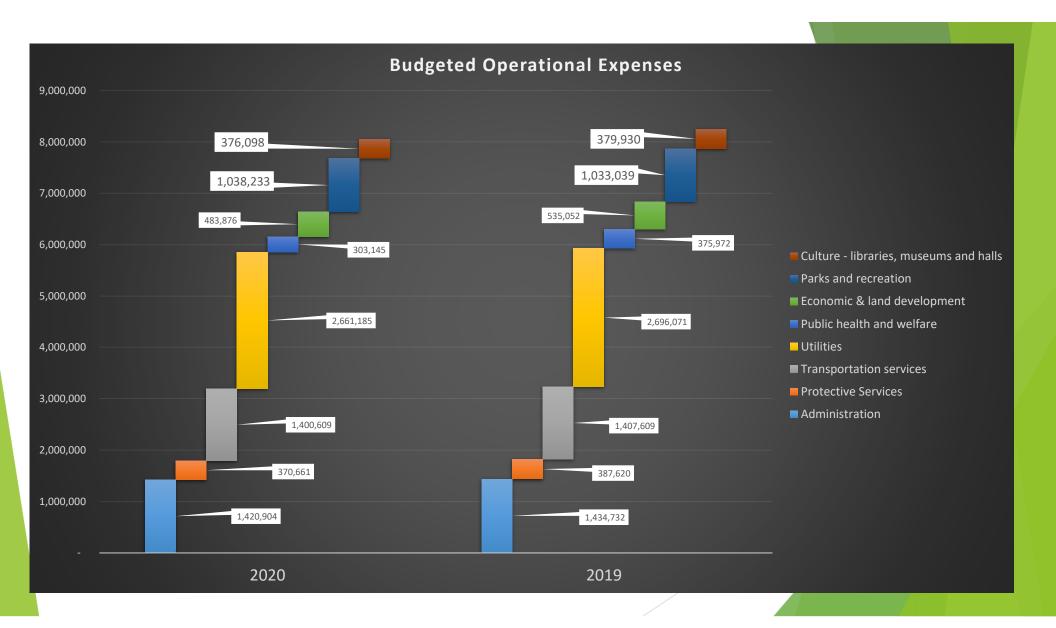

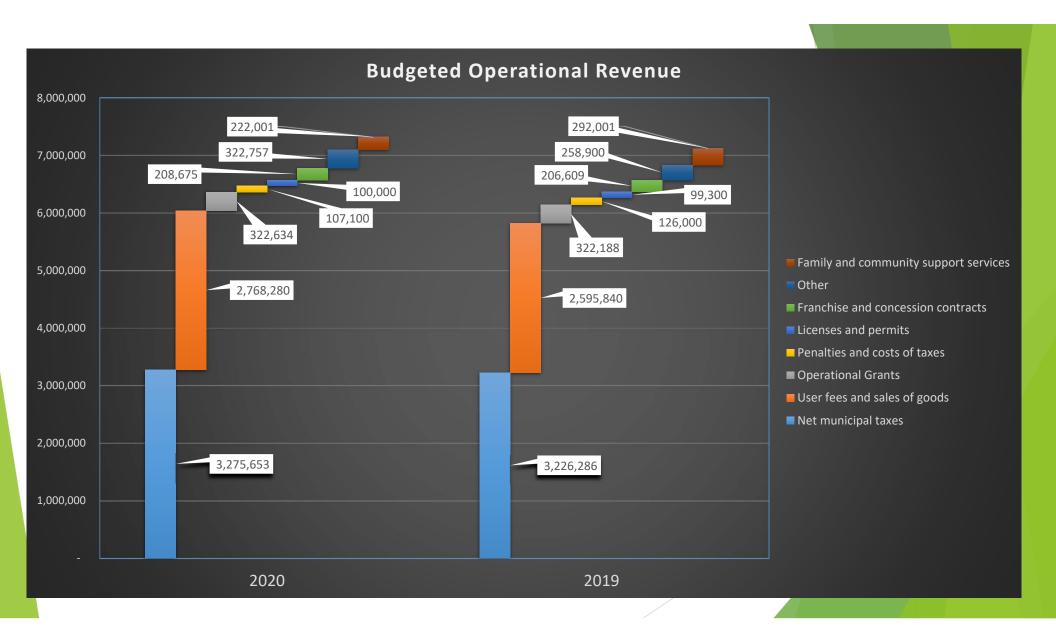
## 2020 Operating Budget - Expenses

- Connect by All Net
- Additional grant funding to the Transportation Society
- Decrease in staffing due to new Blue Bin Recycling Program
- New debt payments for anticipated new loan for Multi-use Building Project
- Over 15K savings in insurance primarily due to removal of old school building
- Continued Economic Development projects such as wayfinding signage on the highway
  - ▶ Rural and Northern Immigration Project lots of interest developing around this
  - ▶ Labour Market Partnership Grant (84K) Business Visitation, Labour force research and analysis, etc.
  - Wayfinding Signage



## 2019 Budget - Revenue

- ▶ 2020 property tax rate has not been set yet as 2019 however an estimated 1.5% increase in municipal tax revenue has been budgeted for. This doesn't necessarily mean a 1.5% increase in individuals taxes as this could partially come from development and growth in Town.
- A utility revenue increase has also been budgeted based on the annual increases noted in the Water & Sewer Utility Bylaw passed last year as well as the new Blue Bin Recycling Program.
- ► Final budget will be passed prior to the 2020 Tax Rate Bylaw being presented for first reading in April or May.
- Unknowns and Estimates that will be adjusted for in the Final Budget
  - Policing Costs (not currently included)
  - Provincial grants (estimated)
  - ► Tax Requisitions School and Porcupine Hills Lodge (estimated)



## 2020 Budget - Capital Projects - Ensuring A Sustainable Future-

- ➤ Continue Storm Water Projects Phase 1 Essentially completed just a bit of carry forward items to finalize Fully grant funded (Alberta Community Resilience Program (ACRP)/Municipal Sustainability Initiative (MSI)).
- Storm Water Projects Phase 2 Cancelled ACRP Funding ended
- 3.8M for Multi-use Community Building 2.8M Debt funded, 1M grant & reserve funded.
- Road paving North Industrial (Saskatchewan Crescent) 450K grant funded
- Infrastructure Master Plan 150K grant funded
- Equipment Front end loader and Skidsteer trade-in 310K
- Arena Roof Replacement and Tennis Court Resurfacing 255K grant funded

Total Capital Expenditures of \$7.1M. \$4.2M Grant Funded, \$2.8M debt funded, with only 5K being tax funded (remainder is donations, trade-in, and reserves).
