CLARESHOLM HISTORY BOOK COMMITTEE - Doug Leeds RE: History Book Loan

Appearing on behalf of the Claresholm History Book Committee was Doug Leeds. Claresholm History Book Volume 2 was started in 2003 and was completed in 2010. They printed 2,000 copies for a cost of \$106,000. After initial sales, \$50,000 was left owing. The Town and the MD of Willow Creek assisted with loans to the committee. The loan from the MD has been paid off and there is \$6,500 still owing to the Town. The group is asking for forgiveness of the remainder of the loan. There are 750 books left and proceeds of any books that are sold going forward would be gifted to the Library.

CLARESHOLM RCMP DETACHMENT - Sergeant Rob Harms RE: Quarterly Update
