RECYCLING AND GARBAGE QUICK REFERENCE GUIDE

Welcome to a Greener Claresholm!

As the Town of Claresholm expands the recycling program to include more items and operate a true-blue bin program, we are pleased to introduce Environmental 360 Solutions to the citizens of Claresholm as the new recycling collector/transporter. E360S will be looking after the collection of the Town's recycling bins from all residential and commercial customers and transport all items to Calgary for drop off at CASCADES automated sorting facility. We chose CASCADES recycling to take our materials to, as they guarantee all products collected will be recycled. The new blue bins, delivered to every home, will be owned by the Town of Claresholm and used for recycling purposes only. All large bins in the commercial areas, will be clearly marked, and are for business use only of recycling materials.

An information package will be dropped off with every residential customer, detailing the products accepted for recycling, bin placing instructions for collection and who to call for questions or problems.

All commercial customers will be contacted for bin requirements, with instructions on where to place their recycling materials and when they will be collected.

The new collection program will commence in November.

For all Residential customers:

The Public Works crew will continue with residential collection as is until the delivery of all residential bins has been completed. Once bins have been delivered, your new collection time and day will be posted on the Town's web site, as well as in the information package that will be handed out when bins are delivered. The package will contain information regarding the materials that will be accepted in the new recycling program. Residential customer will set out their bins for collection once every two weeks.

For those customers that recycle infrequently or that do not want a bin, or only have occasional large quantities, bins will be provided for their use at the Public works shop during working hours. (7am- 4pm weekdays) and they can drop off all accepted items for recycle.

For bin repairs or replacements contact the Town's Public Works department at 403-625-0503 during working hours. Replacements may be at your own cost.

RECYCLE PICK UP: BI-WEEKLY

Starting early November 2019.

Please have your bin on the street curb, in front of your property, by 7 a.m. on your scheduled day of pick up. Do not put your recycling in a bag, leave it loose in the bin. See map on back for your scheduled pick up day.



GARBAGE PICK UP: WEEKLY

Please have bags set out by 7 a.m. on your scheduled day of pick up.

The day of the week that your grabage is picked up may be different than your recycling.



YARD WASTE: 271 59 AVENUE EAST

Bring your tree branches, leaves and grass clippings to the Towns compost pile.

Please seperate your materials into the appropirate piles. Residents are welcome to take any compost for their own purposes.



DOG WASTE:

Please pick up after your pets. Bags are available throughout Claresholm if you forget to bring your own.

There are 2 off-lest dog parks in our community.



SPRING CLEAN UP:

Annual pick up of unwanted items is held every spring. A full list of items that can and cannot be picked up is available on the Town website.

OTHER DISPOSAL OPTIONS:

Willow Creek Regional Landfill: Hours of operation vary seasonally. 403-687-2603 Fees apply.

Household Hazardous Waste:

Claresholm hosts a Toxic Round up in the spring every 2 years, write 2021 & 2023 on your calendar.



Electronics: Electronic Round Up is held annually each spring by the Claresholm & District 4-H Club at the Claresholn Town Shop.

Used Clothing: Claresholm has a number of used clothing drop off bins throughout the community. Or consider donating to or selling your used items on social media.
