2023 DOG LICENSE FEES ARE NOW DUE



DOG OWNERS ARE REMINDED OF THE FOLLOWING:

All dogs are required to have a license and any person found owning or harboring a dog which does not have a valid license may be fined under the Town's dog bylaw; The Town may issue a ticket to the owner or capture and impound any dog found running at large;
License cost for spayed/neutered - \$15/year,
License cost for intact - \$40/year

NOTICE TO BUSINESS OWNERS

Invoices for 2023 Town of Claresholm business licenses have been sent in the mail. Please pay the invoice promptly to ensure your 2023 business license is sent out as early as possible. Persons found operating a business (including home based) without a valid Town of Claresholm 2023 business license may be fined under the Town's business license bylaw.

Regional Business Licenses are available for an additional \$80/year which allows the resident license holder to conduct business in all participating communities.

TAX REDUCTION

A discount of 1.25% will be allowed on the prepayment of 2023 property taxes based on the amount of the 2022 tax levy. The discount will apply to all prepayments (excluding T.I.P.P.s participants) received at the Town Office before Jan. 31, 2023.

Recycling Information

- Please - No items on top of the recycling bins
- Lids must be closed, but **do not use bungee cords**
- No black garbage bags
- Break down all cardboard – do not put built boxes in your bin
- If you have too much recycling, take the overflow to the yellow bin at the town shop. Do not overfill your recycling bin.
- If your bin has not been emptied, check for a tag which will state a reason
- If your bin has not been emptied on your scheduled day & no tag has been left, contact the Town Office
